Special Stadium For Amsterdam Games

AMSTERDAM, Oct. 20.—Private munificence having virtually assured the holding of the Olympic games in Amsterdam in 1928, plans have been drawn for the construction of a special stadium on the outskirts of the city. Owing to the soggy nature of the ground along the Zuider Zee it will be necessary to drive 6,000 piles each 50 feet in length into the sub-soil for a foundation. A million cubic metres of sand will be required to raise the level of the

site. There will be 75,000 square metres of cemented surface. The new stadium grounds will be about 35 acres in size.
