R. McIntosh of St. Mary's, the Committee would only remark, that they appear satisfactory, and give good promise of future prosperity.

With reference to the letter from Brother G. T. Clarris, the Committee heartily concur in the remarks made by the Grand Master in his Report, upon Elgin Lodge No. 32; and sincerely hope that the Brethren of Elgin Lodge therein alluded to, may upon mature reflection, have felt that hasty proceedings are not in accordance with the spirit of Odd Fellowship.
