## To Search For Hidden Jewels

Mariners Set Out to Seek the  
Sapphires of an Ancient  
King.

Men have joined the call of lost  
sapphires, and the little steamer Schenck  
and Casco has carried Robert Louis  
Stevenson to the islands of romance,  
poked her nose through the Golden  
Gate, recently headed for the foun-  
tain Northland, says a story from San  
Francisco.

For several days Captain C. B.  
Oliver and thirty husky seafaring men,  
who believe in a certain chart, had  
been storing provisions in the hold of the  
Casco. They said they were sailing  
to the Arctic for codfish, but  
there could naturally the Casco on a fishing expedition if it  
circled the globe. Old salts along the  
water front shook their heads  
and went to Pier 40 and smoked their  
pipes, and one man of the crew of  
the schooner said:

When I was young there was a great war.

The most powerful king led his armies  
to battle and vanquished all the  
other armies. Then he died.

The king had been noted for his  
fondness of sapphires. His subjects,  
worshipping his memory, made annual  
pilgrimages to his tomb, and each  
deposited at the burial place one or  
two sapphires. That insured the pil-  
grims' speedy entry into the happy  
hereafter.

Centuries passed, as is their wont.  
A natural disaster swept away the  
tomb, and nothing remained except the  
legend. Then the glacier that had  
covered the tomb wore away, and  
an adventurous soul traveled the North  
from the treasure.

The man carried away all the  
sapphires he could carry. He planned  
to return for the rest, but he died  
too soon.

The men of the Casco have a map,  
they say, that directs them to a spot  
beneath the broad ice north of the  
Northern Shores, where lie heaps and  
heaps of sapphires that the worshipers  
laid at the tomb of the One."

Each of the thirty men of the crew  
had subscribed one-thirtieth of the  
expenses of the expedition, and the  
Casco, that once sailed the sunny seas  
of the South, will venture to the  
North in search of codfish and untold wealth.
