The attention of the Grand Division is called to the number of expulsions for other causes—nearly 600—an item which is unusually large, and brings us again face to face with the unsolved problem of years, "How shall we check the enormous loss our Order suffers from the excision of members for non-payment of dues." The Grand Scribe would suggest that the Grand Worthy Patriarch be respectfully requested to address a Circular letter to his Deputies, bringing this matter to their notice, and urging the appointment by Divisions of small Committees to collect dues from members in arrears.

Ten Counties show an increase of members, and nine Counties a decrease, Halifax County still holds the largest number of Divisions, 31. Between Kings and Hants the contest is keen for the largest numbers of members, Kings, with its 1566, leading in the race. The largest net increase of members during the term was in Ahmerst Division, No. 182, which, with its 216 members, is beating to windward of WESTERN STAR, No. 161, which is still the "Banner Division," with 230.
