

In Memoriam.

REV. JOHN McMURRAY, D. D.,

Past Grand Worthy Patriarch.

A MEMBER OF RIVERSIDE DIVISION, No. 324,

Died Dec. 26, 1890.—Aged 76 years.

The deceased was one of the pioneers of this Order. He was initiated into the Grand Division as a Representative of Victoria Division, No. 10, and elected Grand Chaplain in 1848.

In the third year of this Grand Division's history (1849), it attested its appreciation of his judicial mind and administrative abilities, by making him its choice for Grand Worthy Patriarch, and it re-affirmed that expression in 1857. During the forty-one years that elapsed from the time he received its highest honor, until when with his latest breath, the spirit of its Senior Past Grand Worthy Patriarch departed, his interest in its work knew no abatement. Wearing all through his earthly career "the white flower of a blameless life," the memory of his sterling worth and untiring devotion should endure as an inspiration to the membership of this Order.
