

CHAPTER 4.

An Act respecting the Salaries of certain Public Func- AD. 1886. tionaries and other annual charges on the Consolidated Revenue.

ER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. There shall be payable yearly, and pro ratû for any Sums mentioned in this less period than a year, the salaries and sums of money Act, to be paymentioned in the following sections of this Act, to the perable without sons and for the purposes therein specified, and the same vote. shall be payable out of any unappropriated moneys forming part of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of Canada. 31 V., c. 33, s. 2.

2. The salaries of the Lieutenant Governors of the several Salaries of Lt. Provinces shall be as follows, that is to say:-
