An Act to authorize the Canada Eastern Railway Company to convey its railway to the Alexander Gibson Railway and Manufacturing Company.

WHEREAS the Canada Eastern Railway Company has, by Preamble. its petition, represented that the Alexander Gibson Railway and Manufacturing Company was incorporated by an Act of the legislature of the province of New Brunswick, N.B., 1897, 5 being chapter 57 of the statutes of 1897, for the purpose, among others, of acquiring and operating the railway of the said the Canada Eastern Railway Company; and whereas the said last named company has prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of 10 the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:-

1. The Act mentioned in the preamble, incorporating the Provincial Alexander Gibson Railway and Manufacturing Company, Act confirmed. 15 hereinafter called "the Company," is hereby confirmed: Provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed in any way to affect or render inoperative any of the provisions of the said Act, or affect anything done, any right or privilege acquired, Existing or to be acquired, or any liability incurred, or to be incurred, liabilities. 20 under the said Act, to all of which rights and privileges the

Company shall continue to be entitled, and to all of which

liabilities the Company shall continue to be subject.

2. The Canada Eastern Railway Company may sell, trans-Sale to fer and assign to the Company, on the terms mentioned in the of Company of Canada 25 said Act, its railway and branches, together with its rights, Eastern Railway. franchises, powers, privileges, and property; and the Company may thereupon hold, exercise and operate the same under the powers granted by the said Act, and by this Act; provided that such sale has been first sanctioned by the consent in 30 writing of every shareholder of the Company, or, failing such Approval of consent, then by two thirds of the votes of the shareholders shareholders. present or represented by proxy at a special general meeting
