a reply may be given to Racette.

It is possible, I add, that there
may be a small claim, for services
in connection with the visit to
the Province of the Sioux headed
by Little Knife, shortly before
Governor Archibald left here.

Racette claimed, to have
right to represent the Assiniboines,
under a letter from a chief of
that Tribe who left some years
ago for the United States, and
wished to take part in the con-
ference with the Indians, but
the Commissioners refused to
allow him to do so.
