I think the price is a fair one for such a building as it is expected to be a good one and substantial. There will then be \$75.00 Seventy five dollars left for the purpose of enclosing the Church and care of ground.

The Catholic people would like to have a very fancy fence in front of the Church but this amount would not be enough to do, we would simply have to buy the best fence we could get for this amount.

I told Mr Forster, the Architect to see what we could get from the Owen Sound Wire Fence Co. There will have to be two iron gates. I will write about the fence later when I find out how much per rod we can get it for.
