	14-12-40		Intense search started for two missing Northrops near Gravenhurst. Some 35 planes involved operating from Gravenhurst. S/L Bradshaw in charge.	
	15-12-40		No sign of two missing aircraft but a long oil slick was spotted on Lake Muskoka south of Browning Island. It is believed both machines are in lake.	
	16-12-40		Aerodrome in bad shape. Several inches of water under a thin layer of ice. Flying practically suspended.	
	17-12-40		G/B D'Arcy Greig and F/L Dickinson visited Station by air re training.	
	18-12-40		Successful boxing and wrestling show put on in Drill Hall in evening. Lionel Conacher MPP refereed the main bout. A captured German war propaganda film was shown in the theatre.
