

SADDLE LAKE AGENCY

Sir,

I have the honour to submit my report on the annuity payments at this Agency 1901.

Inspector Croshaw of the N.W.M. Police delivered the annuity money here on the evening of the 15th July, 1901. The payments and annuities were commenced at Saddle Lake on Wednesday 17th and completed at La Riche on Tuesday 28th instant.

Seven hundred and forty-five Indians were paid this year, an increase of seven over the previous year. The increase was due to births.

Since the payments in 1900 there has been thirty-eight births and twenty-seven deaths of which nine were adults.
