I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 15th. instant transmitting encrypt from the May 7th. issue of the "Chronicle" and in reply to refer you to letter of even number of 15th. instant;

It is gathered from the passages marked by you that the Municipal Council intends to hold an Indian celebration independently of the Agricultural Exhibition, which is an entirely new aspect of the matter as far as it has been brought to the attention of the Department, and one to deal with which requires further consideration, and may possibly necessitate special Dominion legislation;

Since in any case it is too late to do anything in the matter during the present Session of Parliament it only remains for the present to await the result of the efforts which the Province may make to find a remedy;
