I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of 25th instant transmitting copy of the May Number of the "Wendat" and in reply to refer you to Letter of even number of 18th instant.

It is gathered from the passages marked by you that the Municipal Council intends to hold an Indian celebration independently of the Agricultural Exhibition, which is an entirely new aspect of the matter as far as it has been brought to the attention of the Department, and one to deal with which requires further consideration, and may possibly necessitate special Indian legislation.

Since in my case it is too late to do anything in the matter during the present Session of Parliament it only remains for the present to await the result of the efforts which the Province may make to find a remedy.
