

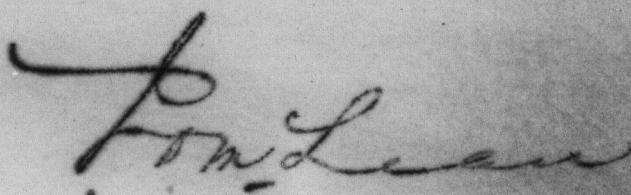
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OTTAWA, 28th July, 1903

Sir,

Referring to Departmental letter of the 2nd August 1900 relative to the age limit for the admission of pupils to boarding and industrial schools, I beg to say that this ruling is only to apply to such pupils as have been taken in on and after 1st October 1900. In the return for June quarter last from the Coqualecton Home, forwarded through your office, it is noticed that you have made this ruling apply to pupils admitted previous to that date.
