Gentleman,-


With reference to your letter of the 7th instant in which you state that you wrote this Department two weeks ago on behalf of the Toronto and Niagara Power Company in regard to the procedure to be adopted in acquiring title to certain lands in the Township of Onondaga in the County of Brant, I beg to state that the following letter was sent you on the 20th ultimo:-

" I beg to acknowledge your letter of the 17th instant, and in reply thereto would say that you should file with this Department copies, (on tracing cloth) of those portions of the location plans of the Toronto and Niagara Power Company, which show the Indian lands your Company require. This plan or plans should be certified by the Chief Engineer of Railways and Canals, his certificate will be to the effect that the lands are actually required for the purposes of your Company."

"I notice that you suggest the price of \$100. per acre. On the receipt of the said plans, your application will be taken into further consideration."
