



Ottawa, April 30, 1907.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th inst., inclosing a resolution of the Fort William Indians and a copy of a letter addressed to Bishop O'Connor, of Peterborough, setting forth that, in the event of the Sisters Of St. Joseph not erecting a convent and school on the new reserve, they be asked to refund the amount of money granted by the band for the erection of the Orphanage, together with the amount received from the sale of the land upon which the convent stood; and in reply I beg to say that the Department will await the reply of Bishop O'Connor before any further action is taken in this matter.
