
Ottawa, August 12, 1913.

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 2nd inst., I beg to inform you that Messrs. Lawrence Mary & Son., West Arichat, C.B., are the contractors for the Indian Cove School and the contract price is two thousand, two hundred and ninety-eight dollars. The specifications call for stone in the foundation but they have been authorized to substitute concrete for stone the concrete to be mixed in the following proportions:- One cement, two and one half sand, and five stone.

The Department is not aware of the exact date when they will commence the work but they have been asked to advise you.
