In reply to your letter of the 16th instant in regard to your proposal to distribute garden seed and Sir, rotate seed next spring to Indiana of your agency, I beg to say that you may incur an expenditure of \$50.00 in this connection. When giving out the seed you should casure yourself that only these Indiane who are likely to make good use of it share in the distribution. The seeds should not be given out until the land has been prepared for sowing and you should give such advice of a general character, as the Indiana may require, in regard to the planting of their land.
