Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 16th instant, in regard to your proposal to distribute garden seed and potato seed next spring to Indians of your agency, I beg to say that you may incur an expenditure of \$50.00 in this connection. When giving out the seed you should ensure yourself that only those Indians who are likely to make good use of it share in the distribution. The seeds should not be given out until the land has been prepared for sowing and you should give such advice of a general character, as the Indians may require, in regard to the planting of their land.
