## MEETING OF THE BOARD, NEW YORK, MARCH 21-22, 1946.

1. The Permanent Joint Board on Defense met in New York on Thursday, March 21, 1946, at 2:00 p.m. at the Waldorf-Astoria Hotel. The following members participated:

General McNaughton and Mr. LaGuardia expressed, on behalf of their respective Sections of the Board, sorrow at the death of Admiral Jones and paid tribute to his significant and greatly valued contributions to the work of the Board.
