Synopsis of Canadian North-West.

HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

NY even-numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, and Alberta, excepting 8 and 25, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the soie head of a family, or any male over 15 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 168 acres, more or less.

Application for entry must be made in person by the applicant at a Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district in which the land is situate. Entry by proxy, may, however, be made at any Agency on certain conditions by the father, mother, son, daughter, brother, or sister of an intending homestader.

DUTIES. - (1) At least six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(f) A homesteader may if he so desires, perform the required residence duties by living on farming land owned solely sole him, not less than eightly (60) across in extent, in the vicinity of his homestead. He may be a living with father or mother, on certain conditions. Joint owner-ship in land will not meet this re-

(3) A homesteader intending to perform his residence duties in accordance with the above while living with parents or on farming land owned by himself much notify the agent for the district of such intention.
