**THE APPEARANCES OF OUR LORD.**

**The Ascension.**

There are eleven recorded Appearances of our Blessed Lord during the Great Forty Days after His Resurrection. There may have been others, of which the Holy Scriptures do not tell us. But we know that in this time He was "speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God," His Church.

The eighth Appearance was probably to the five hundred brethren at once, of which St. Paul tells us. These were, no doubt, His disciples, not the Apostles, who were most likely not present.

The ninth Appearance was to the eleven Apostles on a mountain in Galilee, where Jesus, the night before His Crucifixion, told them He would meet them. Here He gave them the great commission to baptize.

St. Paul tells us that our Lord appeared to St. James, but gives us no account of it. This is the tenth Appearance.

The eleventh Appearance was when Jesus ascended into Heaven. After they had assembled again at Jerusalem, He led them out to the top of the Mount of Olives. He charged them to wait in Jerusalem until the Holy Ghost came upon them.

He lifted up His Hands, and blessed them. While He blessed them they saw Him slowly rise, and ascend up into Heaven; and a cloud received Him out of their sight.
