Rebellion and That Sort of Thing.

No sooner is the insurrection quelled in the Northwest than news comes of a threatened rebellion in British Columbia, arising out of dissatisfaction with the price offered by the Government upon the Dominion lands.

The person who shall have first settled the land before the improvements on Dominion lands before such confirmed survey may take out the land so settled upon, and after the land shall have been staked out to him, in addition to the prior right of obtaining homestead entry, he is entitled to the same as a settler.

At the expiration of three years from the date of his perfecting his homestead entry, the settler, upon proving to the satisfaction of the agent that he has resided upon and cultivated the land during the said term of three years, shall be entitled to a patent for the land on payment of one dollar per acre.

These regulations appear very just and designed, in every possible way to protect the settlers, so that we fail to see how any ground for complaint can be made against them.

We believe that, when full enquiry has been made into all the circumstances connected with the North-west rebellion, it will be found that little, if any, cause for complaint can be made against the Government.

But the Government owe a duty to the Dominion at large, as well as to the residents of the Northwest, and it is part of their duty to protect the treasury of the people, the money of the people, and the money's worth of the people, whether that money consists of land or of other property.

Rebellion is rather too expensive a game to be indulged in at the pleasure of a few restless spirits living on the Northwest frontier. To suppress the recent insurrection has cost millions of money, and what is worse than all, the lives of many of our best and bravest citizens, and upon the inhabitants of the older provinces has devolved by far the heaviest portion of this expenditure of blood and treasure.

It is in spite of the evil effect which it was feared the North-West Rebellion would have upon the credit of the Dominion in the London money market, we are happy in being able to announce that Sir Leonard Tilley has succeeded in floating a loan for twenty-five million dollars at four per cent, with which to replace the twenty-five millions at five per cent. now due.

We are sure that the great majority of our people will be gratified to learn that Sullivan, the Boston pugilist, with a most chilling reception the other day in St. John, the hall, in which his "performance" was given, was not half full of people, and his presence in the city, contrary to the expectations of his admirers, created no stir at all.

Death of Monsignor Bourget.

This telegraph wire has just flashed through Canada news of the death of one of the greatest spirits of Canadian history. At the ripe old age of eighty-six the Right Reverend Ignace Bourget has been called to his reward.

He was a marked man, and his name is a name which will live in the annals of Canadian history. He was for some years Secretary to the Government of the Dominion, and in consideration of the construction of the Pacific Railway, the Government of British Columbia transferred to the Dominion Government a belt of land extending in width twenty miles on each side of the railway.

He was instrumental in bringing the Oblat Fathers into the diocese, where they arrived on the 1st of December, 1841. He also re-established the Jesuits in Canada, the Rev. Father Asselin on the 1st of June, 1842. The ladies of the Sacred Heart, in obedience to a request of Mgr. Bourget, sent a band of their Religious from the Rue de Valenciennes in Paris to Montreal in December, 1842.
