LIVE HOGS ARE AGAIN ON JUMP

Price Was Boosted This Morning to \$8.40 Per Hundred.

MARKET A SMALL ONE

Hay Sold Well, But Supply Was Small—Oats Were Easier.

There was a comparatively small market this morning, but the prices prevailing were very good and sales exceptionally brisk. Live hogs are again on the upward flight, and this morning reached quite an unusual figure, \$8.40 being paid. Hay sold very well. The supply was comparatively small, only some dozen or so loads being offered. The prevailing price this morning was \$15.50, while a few loads reached the higher figure of \$16. Oats showed a tendency to be easier. There were only a few loads offered, and the highest prices offered was \$12.75, and \$1.50 was paid for some loads.

Wheat and other grains were very scarce, as was also straw, though there was a very good demand for all. Other prices remain as follows:
