





The body was identified by a Mrs. Beliveau, of Lachine, as that of her husband who had been missing for several days. An inquest was held, a verdict of accidental death returned and the corpse interred.

For a while all went well, and Mrs. Beliveau prepared to marry again. Her horror, therefore, can be imagined when the other day the 'ghost" of her husband returned and claimed the right to occupy former position. The case was therefore brought to the attention of the coroner. The "ghost" claims that he had been serving a six months sentence in jail.






