

(b) Return a receipt for material received, guaranteeing all expenses of shipment, the safe return, free of charge, to Montreal or such other point as may be designated, and all expense arising through loss or damage while in his hands.

(c) Undertake to deliver the lecture or provide a competent substitute.

(d) Supply the necessary lantern unless otherwise provided.

3. The lectures shall in all cases be free to teachers and such of the general public as may desire to attend.

4. The lectures may be given to artisans on public holidays on the same terms as to teachers.

5. Returns of attendance shall be furnished to the Committee on forms provided for that purpose.

6. No lecture may be used by the contracting party in any locality other than that specified in the application, except by special permission.

Under special arrangements with Prof. A. S. Bickmore of the American Museum of Natural History, New York, the Committee is able to avail itself of the well known series of Bickmore illustrated lectures as prepared under authority of the Superintendent of Public Instruction for the State of New York, and delivered at the American Museum and throughout the State to the teachers of the public schools.

Nine of these lectures are now available and may be obtained under the conditions stated above. The subjects are as follows:
