Mr. Secretary,

I have the honour to refer to the discussions which took place recently between officials on The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority of Canada and the Saint Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation of the United States regarding the Memorandum of Agreement between those agencies, dated January 29, 1959, and the Tariff of Tolls set out therein, which were attached to the (1) Exchange of Notes of March 9, 1959, between our two Governments, and amended in 1964, 1967, 1972, 1978, 1980, 1982, 1984, 1985, (10) (11) (12) (13) (14) 1986, 1987, 1988, 1989 and 1991.

The discussions resulted in the signature of the enclosed Memorandum of Agreement by the Administrator of the Saint Lawrence Seaway Development Corporation at Washington, D.C. on January 28, 1992, and by the President of The St. Lawrence Seaway Authority at Ottawa on January 30, 1992. This Memorandum of Agreement sets forth amendments to the Memorandum of Agreement of January 1959, as amended, which deal with the tariff classification of materials for recycling and the extension of the incentive tolls program to passenger vessels.
