

The departmental joint management/employee Parking Review Committee will be undertaking, prior to October 1987 parking renewal date, a review of the existing criteria used to determine eligibility for parking with a view to defining in a more precise, yet flexible, manner the criteria to be used in handling requests for parking on "compassionate" grounds.

Employees who submit requests for parking permits after the annual October renewal date and who qualify for parking have their names placed on a priority list in the order the request was received. The priority list is used to fill parking spaces as they become available during the course of the year.

#### Building Maintenance and Housekeeping

External Affairs management has again been in touch with management of the Department of Public Works (DPW) expressing the Department's displeasure over the deterioration in the building maintenance and housekeeping services being provided at the Pearson Building.

A progress report was provided as to what measures have been implemented by DPW since the 19 November EAJC meeting to correct the problems identified at that time. Four vacant cleaning positions have been staffed and a DPW supervisor is working evenings to supervise the cleaning staff, which has already solved a number of work quality and attendance problems.

Complaints or queries concerning building maintenance and housekeeping should be directed to MFM the area responsible for liaising with DPW on such issues.
