

has been completed, unless terminated earlier by mutual agreement or by either party after sixty days notice in writing to the other party of its intention to terminate the agreement.

If the foregoing provisions are acceptable to the Government of Canada, I have the honor to propose that your reply to this effect and this note shall constitute an agreement between the Governments of the United States and Canada regarding this matter, which shall enter into force on the date of your reply with effect from April 1, 1972.
