

OECD. Barriers to Trade with the Economies in Transition. Paris: OECD, 1994. This study examines the problem of trade barriers in relation to the Eastern European countries and the states of the former Soviet Union. It considers both OECD barriers to these countries and the internal barriers between them.

OECD. Integrating Emerging Market Economies into the International Trading System. OECD, 1994. Examines trade issues of the East European states and the states of the former Soviet Union. The focus is on those aspects of the trade policy that are most important for the transition process and the main issues concerning the integration of the transforming economies into the international trading system.
