Of D. D. Broadfoot and others, of Regina, Province of Saskatchewan; praying for an Act of Incorporation under the name of the British Canadian Loan Company.

Of the Montreal Central Terminal Company; praying for the passing of an Act to extend the time for the completion of its undertaking.

Of the Architectural Institute of Canada; praying for the passing of an Act to change their name to that of 'the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada, or L'Institut Royal d'Architecture du Canada, and for other purposes.

Of the Dominion Guarantee Company, Limited; praying for the passing of an Act to change their name to that of the Dominion Gresham Guarantee and Casualty Company.

Of Thomas D.
