been enjoying these benefits if they were suddenly subject to tax. The Government did not see it as appropriate to change the general provisions requiring the taxation of benefits, but at the same time would allow some time for study as to possible alternatives.

Adjournment Debate

Mr. Deputy Speaker: The motion to adjourn the House is now deemed to have been adopted. Accordingly, the House stands adjourned until eleven o'clock tomorrow morning.
