9. The titular head of Medicine, who at the same time shall be Chief of Clinic in one Hospital.

10. The Chief of Clinic in Medicine in the other Mospital, who shall at the same time have full Professorial rank,

11. The titular head of Surgery, who at the same time shall be Chief of Clinic in one Hospital,

12. The Chief of Clinic in Surgery in the other Hospital, who at the same time shall have full Professorial rank, 13. The Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology,

14. The Professor of Oto-Luryngology,

15. The Professor of Ophthalmology,

16. The Dean, and the Assistant Dean, if not included in the above list. -----

(1) The Dean of the Faculty shall be the Chairman of the Council and in his absence the Senior Member present.

(2) The Council shall meet at least four times during the Session, or more frequently if deemed necessary, at the call of the Dean of the Assistant Dean.

(3) The Council shall be the Executive of the Faculty and shall conduct its business.

STANDING COLLITTEES.

I. The Executive Committee The Executive Committee shall be appointed by the Council, and shall consist of, the Dean, the Assistant Dean (Chairman) and three others of its Members.

It shall hold weekly meetings or at the call of the Chairman as frequently as may be deemed necessary.

It shall transact all the business of the Faculty except that which is concerned with appointments, or which may involve a

change in any policy of the Faculty. The Executive Committee shall be responsible to the Council and shall report to that body. It shall also prepare the business for the ordinary meetings of the Council.

2. The Education Committee: This Committee shall consist of ten members, to be chosen from amongst the members of the Faculty. It shall meet at least once every fortnight and shall consider such matters as may be referred to it by the Faculty, the Council, or the Executive Committee.

It shall report the results of its deliberations to the Faculty and shall prepare all the business of the meetings of that body.
