

cannot afford to neglect the presence of these parasites in the fur-bearing animals of the north, but our difficulty is to get entrails of these animals for examination. May we hope to enlist the help of your force, the Mounted Police, in this work? You have your stations everywhere throughout this country, in Yukon, the Northwest Territories, Labrador, and it may be possible for them to shoot some of these animals and engage to send us such parts of the bodies as are necessary for laboratory examination. Dr. Tory, Chairman of the National Research Council, intends to speak to you, while Dr. Cameron is to give you a more detailed statement of what would be of use to him and how it is done. He tells me that in Scotland, where he came from, the police were of assistance to him in sending him samples from outlying districts. When the problem is presented to you in this detailed fashion, will you give it your sympathetic consideration? I should gladly answer or cause to be answered any questions you may have to ask.
