V.

Every Member of this Lodge shall commence the payment of Monthly dues on the day of his admission, or on receiving the third degree of Masonry; and no Brother shall be permitted to vote at the annual election of Master and Treasurer, until they shall have been duly paid to the Secretary, nor shall any Brother be allowed to withdraw his name from the Books of the Lodge until all dues shall have been liquidated.

VI.

Any Member who shall so far forget the respect due to himself and the Members of this Lodge as to appear in a state of inebriety, or not in clean and decent apparel, or who shall make use of any immoral or uncourteous language; or who by any improper conduct and behaviour shall disturb the peace and harmony of the Lodge, for the first offence he shall be admonished by the Master, and for the second offence of the same nature he shall be ordered to leave the Room for the evening; and should he on a third occasion be guilty of similar disrespect and impropriety, he shall be suspended by a voice of the majority of the Members present, until he make a proper acknowledgment of his fault and promise amendment.

VII.

In every debate concerning the affairs of the Ledge, complaint made, or question that may arise, every Member shall stand up while he speaks, and
