MONDAY, afternoon May 7, will leave his own stable, Hampton, and proceed to Thos. Harness', lot 32, con. 5, Clarke, night.

TUESDAY, proceed to Wm. Graham's, lot 17, con. 3, Clarke, noon, thence to Temperance House, Newtonville, night.

WEDNESDAY, proceed to Alfred Harness', Roseberry Hill, noon; thence to Richard Smith's, Shiloh, night.

- THURSDAY, proceed to Dennis White's, Elizabethville, noon; thence to Peter Blue's Hotel, Kendal, night.
- FRIDAY, proceed to Alex Henry's, lot 16, con 6, noon; thence to Thos. Harness,' night.

SATURDAY, proceed to his own stable and remain there until the following Monday afternoon.

The above route will be continued during the season, health and weather permitting.

TERMS
