

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL SD-4.

An Act for the relief of Matilda Aboud Henrig,
otherwise known as Matilda Aboud Levac.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Matilda Aboud Henrig, otherwise known as
Matilda Aboud Levac, residing at the city of Montreal,
in the province of Quebec, wife of George Henrig, otherwise
known as Henry Levac, who is domiciled in Canada and
residing at the city of St. Laurent, in the said province, 5
has by her petition alleged that they were married on the
fourth day of September, A.D. 1942, at the said city of
Montreal, she then being Matilda Aboud; and whereas by
her petition she has prayed that, on the ground of his
adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas 10
the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence
adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition
be granted: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice
and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of
Canada, enacts as follows:— 15

Marriage
dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved, and shall be
henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes what-
soever.
