

Constitution.

BY-LAWS.

- Title.** 1. The Association shall be known as the "MANITOBA CLUB."
- Prohibited subjects.** 2. Politics and religious questions of every description shall be absolutely excluded from the objects of the Club.
- Admission.** 3. Admission to the Club shall be by ballot. Each candidate for admission shall be proposed by one ordinary member, and seconded by another, by a written proposal addressed to the secretary, who shall post the name of such candidate, with the names of his proposer and seconder, in the place in the Club designated for that purpose, for at least fourteen days previous to the day of ballot. Notice of such ballot shall be mailed to each resident member at least seven days previous to the day of ballot.
- Ballot.** 4. The ballot shall be held on the second Wednesday in each month, between the hours of nine o'clock a. m. and seven o'clock p.m.; no ballot shall be valid unless at least twenty members vote, and one adverse vote in each five votes shall exclude.
