CORPORATION LAW. At a Common Council held at the Council Chamber on the eleventh day of June, A. D. 1845: Read and Enacted the following Law.

WHEREAS in and by an Act of the General Assembly of this Province, made and passed in the forty-first year of the Reign of King George the Third, entitled "An Act for the further and better support of the Poor in the City of Saint John," it is enacted that the Mayor, Aldermen, and Commonalty of the City of Saint John be authorized yearly and every year to lay a Tax upon Dogs, to be levied upon the owner or owners of the same, being within the limits of the said City, and collected in such manner as the Corporation of the said City shall by Law or Ordinance appoint...
