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The Queen and the Royal Family.

THE QUEEN.—Victoria, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, Queen, Empress of India, Defender of the Faith. Her Majesty was born at Kensington Palace, May 24th, 1819; succeeded to the throne June 20th, 1837, on the death of her uncle King William IV; was crowned June 28th, 1838; and married Feb. 10th, 1840, to His Royal Highness Prince Albert. Her Majesty is the only child of his late Royal Highness Edward, Duke of Kent, son of King George III. The children of her Majesty are—

Her Royal Highness Victoria Adelaide Mary Louise, PRINCESS ROYAL OF ENGLAND AND PRUSSIA, born Nov. 21st, 1840, and married to His Royal Highness William, the Crown Prince of Germany, Jan. 25, 1858, and has had issue four sons and four daughters.

His Royal Highness Albert Edward, PRINCE OF WALES, born Nov. 9th, 1841; married March 10, 1863, Princess Alexandra of Denmark, born Dec 1, 1844, and has issue, Prince Albert Victor, born January 8, 1864, George Frederick Ernest Albert, born June 3, 1865; Louisa Victoria Alexandra Dagmar, born February 20, 1867; Victoria Alexandra Olga Mary, born July 6, 1868; and Maud Charlotte Mary Victoria, born Nov. 23, 1869.

Her Royal Highness Alice Maud Mary, born April 25, 1843, married to H R H Prince Frederick Louis of Hesse, July 1, 1862, and had issue five daughters and one son; second son killed by accident May 1873. Died Dec. 14, 1878.

His Royal Highness Alfred Ernest Albert, Duke of Edinburgh, born August 6, 1844; married to Her Imperial Highness the Grand Duchess Marie of Russia, Jan. 23rd, 1874, and has issue one son.

Her Royal Highness Helena Augusta Victoria, born May 25, 1846; married to H. R. H. Prince Frederick Christian Charles Augustus of Schleswig-Holstein Sondenberg-Augustenburg, July 5, 1866, and has issue two sons and two daughters.

Her Royal Highness Louise Caroline Alberta, born March 15, 1848; married to the Marquis of Lorne, eldest son of the Duke of Argyll, Governor-General of Canada, March, 1871.

His Royal Highness Arthur William Patrick Albert, Duke of Connaught, born May 1, 1850; married Princess Thyra, of Denmark.
