### BETTER LEAVE IT ALONE

The old bell of Kaskasia having been ordered sent to diocesan headquarters at Belleville, residents near the site of the now vanished church of which it once formed a part—first of the five churches in the Liberty Bell of Philadelphia was to the thirteen colonies and the Bell of Dolores, which Fr. Hidalgo rang in 1810, was to the Mexicans, Boy Bell of Kaskasia is to the Mississippi Valley. It was not the general practice of the ancient fabricators of bells to execute an order at their home foundry, and then trust to the meager transportation facilities of the time to deliver the weighty output at the place for which it was destined. They proceeded to the town from which the order had come, set up their furnaces, and cast the bell in the very locality which for long years would listen to its tones.

It was impractical, however, to ask members of this important guild to journey, in the old days, to the New World. The bells installed in colonial churches were generally of European manufacture. Perhaps that is one reason why most of the colonial bells were rather small. At any rate, when Louis XV wished to present a bell to the "Church in Illinois across the sea," he directed that one should be cast at La Rochelle. That was in 1741, and in subsequent months it reached Kaskasia via New Orleans. It antedated by a full ten years the arrival of the Liberty Bell at Philadelphia. It weighed 700 pounds.

No locality can assert as perfect a title to this old bell as the locality with which it has been associated for 175 years, and which has retained possession of it. Its claim, which it would seem that only the heirs of old Louis could revoke, should be surrendered only on affirmative showing of neglect and failure to appreciate the value of an asset so worthy of being magnified. Now Kaskasia denies neglect and failure to appreciate—St. Louis Post-Dispatch.
