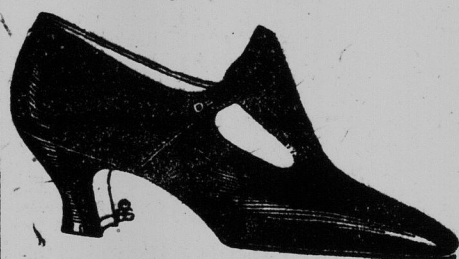

### RECENT DEATHS

George P. Matthew, LL.D., D.Sc., F.R.S.C., noted scientist and author, died on Saturday in New York at the age of eighty-six years. Dr. Matthew was a student of geology in the Maritime Provinces for more than fifty years. His last visit here was on October 7, 1921, when he was the guest of honor at a banquet in the Union Club at which Lieutenant-Governor Pugsley, Premier Foster, Mayor Schofield and many other prominent citizens were present. For the last two years, Dr. Matthew has made his home with his son, Dr. William Diller Matthew, at Hastings-on-the-Hudson, N. Y., and funeral services were held there. Interment will take place at Gonsola Point, Kings county, N. B.

George Frederick Matthew was a son of George and P. Eliza (Harris) Matthew. He was born on Aug. 12, 1837, in St. John and educated at the St. John Grammar School. Dr. Matthew was awarded honorary degrees of M. A. and LL. D. by the University of New Brunswick in 1878 and 1897, respectively, while Laval University in 1894 conferred on him the honorary degree of D. Sc., a rare honor.

He entered the public service in May, 1862, and was appointed chief clerk of the Customs Service, St. John, in May, 1879, and surveyor, July 1, 1893. He retired from the customs service in February, 1915.

Dr. Matthew was appointed a Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society, London, England, in 1866; a few years ago that society awarded him the Murchison medal, one of the most prized awards, for his work in making known the geology of New Brunswick. He was a charter member of the Royal Society of Canada, 1882; charter member of the Natural History Society of New Brunswick, 1868; member of the Geographical Society of Belgium, 1914; member of the Eclectic Reading Club since 1870.

He was a member of the Geological Survey of Canada in the time of Sir William Dawson and Dr. George Dawson. During the Geological Congress held in Washington, U. S. A., in 1890, Gier, of Sweden, and Dr. Barrois, of France, came to St. John purposely to see Dr. Matthew and his work in the province.

Among the sixty or seventy correspondents with whom he exchanged publications were Dr. Woodward, of the British Museum, and others in St. Petersburg and Japan, as well as several in France, many in Sweden and Norway and the British Isles, also a large number through all parts of the United States.

### Thomas Urban Kane

The death of Thomas Urban Kane, son of Thomas and Jennie Kane, occurred yesterday at the General Public Hospital after a several weeks' illness. Mr. Kane was twenty-eight years of age and he had a wide circle of friends in this city who will sincerely regret to learn of his death. He was of a bright and genial disposition and he was a general favorite with all who knew him. He leaves, besides his parents, four brothers, George, Patrick and Colburn, all of this city, and Eugene, of Boston; also two sisters, Mrs. H. L. McKean, of this city, and Miss Ida, at home.

### Miss Alice M. Reid

The death of Miss Alice M. Reid, daughter of the late John and Rachel Reid, occurred yesterday. She had been ill for about three months. The late Miss Reid was for several years a valued employee of the Corona Co., Ltd. She is survived by one brother, William, of this city, for many years a member of the fire department. The funeral will take place on Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from her late residence, 24 Prince Edward street.

### Hardy A. Pittman

The death of Hardy A. Pittman occurred on Monday at his home in Acadia, N. S., at the age of thirty-seven years. Miss Anna and Miss Mary Pittman, student nurses in St. John, are sisters.

### Mrs. G. Douglas Gibbs

Mrs. G. Douglas Gibbs died at her home in Fredericton on Tuesday at the age of thirty-three years.

### Mrs. Eunice A. Somers

The death of Mrs. Eunice A. Somers occurred on Tuesday at the home of her son in Collins, N. B., following an attack of the grippe. She was seventy-six years of age and is survived by one son, one daughter, five grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
