DRIVE FOR \$100,000 IN NEW BRUNSWICK; HALF IN THIS COUNTY

From all over the province men gathered for a meeting at the board of trade rooms yesterday afternoon to decide on the amount which New Brunswick should subscribe to the Red Triangle fund \$2,500,000, now needed by the Y. M. C. A. overseas from Canada. It was announced that instead of aiming seeking for support, a drive should be made along the lines of the Victory loan drive for aid for the Y. M. C. A.

Calhoun, international secretary, New York; and Taylor Statton, superintendent of powers of the Soil for Canadian Food Board, Ottawa.

Jules H. J. McLatchey of Campbellton; Angus McLean of Bathurst; G. Percy Burchill of Miramichi; A. D. Ganong of St. Stephen, and Hon. C. J. Osmen of Hillsboro, members of the provincial committee, who have gladly consented to represent their counties, were unable to be present.
