Letter Written by Roosevelt Before He Left Office Just Made Public.

"We Americans," the letter says,
"owe much to Ireland and Sir Horace

trying to do in the United States, and
before I leave the Presidency I want
to acknowledge our debt and send
through you our thanks for the help
we had—not only my thanks, but the
thanks of every man who knows what
has been done and sees the need and
sure results of this great movement to
help the men and women who feed the
nation and stand as the foundation of
its greatness and progress." "We Americans," the letter savs its greatness and progress."
