10 PER CENT DECREASE IN TOURIST TRAFFIC. Figures Issued Today Show Trade About the Same as That of 1930 in New Brunswick Than Any of Maritime Provinces for Current Year. Traffic from Quebec and Ontario increased.

B., November 18, 1932. — Statistics, issued today by the New Brunswick Government Bureau of Information and Tourist Travel show a decrease of 10 per cent in the tourist trade in this province up to October 31st of this year as compared to the corresponding period in 1931.
