at a meeting of the Indians of his tribe, while they consented to send their Children to school and to everything else the agent proposed, they declined to quie up the Potlack, Soying that they were advised by apit Hitzstubber constable that the lave had no Jower to Jourish it do an offence, and that they comed to on as they had been dany. The agent uddo that this constable is tre fet an under pay even after Capit Fiz 8hubbs' departure for the coast. The undersigned considers that this is a very serious matter, and that it wered be advisable to bring it formally to the notice of the Provincial Government through the proper channel, with a
