[To the Associated Press.] LONDON, Feb. 6. Consols 92 1/2. Breadstuffs quiet. On the 23rd inst. Gen. Morison entered Nova Scotia, eight miles from Pampeluna, by the road from Saragossa, with 2000 men. He would enter Pampeluna and probably attack Caracas simultaneously from the rear, having never turned that important position.

MADRID, Feb. 6. Official despatches have been received at the Ministry of War, announcing that eight battalions of Carlists made a furious attack upon King Alfonso's troops near Orleans, making bayonet charges, but were repulsed with great loss. Despatches have also been received reporting other successes by the national troops.

A decree has been issued directing military and naval officers to abstain from attacking political meetings.

NEW YORK, Feb. 6. Gold 114 1/4. Exchange 44.86 a \$4.89. It is stated that \$200,000 worth of goods have been smuggled from Montreal into the United States in a single day.

CAPT. GEN. COCHA, of Cuba, will take command of the national troops, and all danger to Ciego Villas has ceased.

LONDON, Feb. 8. MONEY MARKET. Subscriptions for the Paris municipal loan amount to forty-two times the amount required.

SPAIN'S CIVIL WAR. Twelve cannon, 4,000 rifles, and 500,000 cartridges, were landed for the Carlists on the coast of Biscay on Saturday. Fighting continues in the vicinity of Estella, Spain. The Carlists have concentrated to occupy about the same position they held when Gen. Cocha was killed.

Pampeluna is saved. King Alfonso entered the city Friday.

CUBA. The Spanish Government will indemnify loyal subjects in Cuba for the damages caused by the war, by selling properties belonging to insurgents when condemned by the tribunals.

More troops are going from Spain to Cuba.

DEATH OF AN EARL. The Earl of Yarborough died in London yesterday, aged 40 years.

SEKOR MERRY has been appointed Diplomatic representative of Spain at Berlin.

NEW YORK, Feb. 8. A FIRE in the Shaker settlement at Lebanon, N. Y., Saturday, did damage to the amount of \$70,000.

FATAL BOILER EXPLOSION. By the explosion of a boiler in sawmills at Germantown, Ohio, yesterday, Peter Schneider was killed, and six others badly wounded, two of whom will probably die.

TELEGRAPHIC RATES. The rates of the Western Union and Atlantic & Pacific Telegraph Companies are to be considerably reduced.

(Special to Daily News.) OTTAWA, Feb. 6. The Report of the Minister of Indian Revenue, submitted to Parliament, gives a Comparative Statement of accrued revenues in this Department. The total revenue accrued during the fiscal year just closed was \$6,859,848, as against \$5,421,233 for the previous year, and \$6,619,012 for the year 1871-72, an increase of 24 per cent. compared with the former and 214 per cent. as compared with the average of three previous years.
