BADGE ENCASEMENT FOR FORMER MEMBERS If you are a former member of the RCMP who left the Force before the mid-1980s, you may be eligible to have your badge encased in acrylic. To date, close to 400 former members have taken advantage of the opportunity to obtain this unique

memento of their service in the Force. Recently, the RCMP dispensed with a previous condition that required a minimum ten year period of service, opening the program to all former members who left the Force in good standing. The cost of the badge and encasement is \$100, with all applicable taxes and expenses included in this price.
