**HYDRO LINEMEN**  
Kept Busy as Result of Storm Tuesday Night.

Street and heavy wet snow which accumulated over the home stretch of the hydro wire gave the line men of the local staff considerable trouble during the night and the early hours of this morning, the sudden accession of weight on the wires caused a large number of breaks and a consequent disorganization of service.

The accumulation of snow and ice not only adds greatly to the weight of the wires, but by the greatly increased surface which the mass offers to the wind, especially when high winds prevail, cause such excessive strain on the poles that the same are frequently torn off, and occasionally the pole itself gives way under the strain.

The number of wires carried by a pole, the greater the resultant strain and increased liability of breakage.

Owing to the much larger number of wires carried upon the telephone company's poles the tendency to breakage on their lines are greater, and the company's line men are frequently kept busy for days after such a storm as last night's in restoring the service to normal conditions.
