"How do you make it?"

"I make it by putting my right hand to my forehead, then to my breast, next to my left shoulder, and lastly to my right shoulder."

All religion, which consists in outward forms, rather than in true holiness, spiritual worship and sound morality, is deceptive, corrupting, Babylonish, and anti-christian, whatever name this religion may have, whether Roman Catholic, or some other name.— Many churches, which do not submit to the Bishop of Rome, and many even which call themselves Protestant, have the spirit of the Catholic Church; and they will partake of the curse pronounced in Revelation on the
